Associates fields almost 20 teams in the WAJRU competition aged from Under 7's through to Under 17's. There are around 300 players and their families who come down to Allen Park each Thursday evening. The bar provides drinks and food and a team roster manned by parents provides a sausage sizzle – toddlers run around and hone their skills while the sun sets behind us on Swanbourne Beach. It is a vibrant place and we welcome new and returning players.

#### TRAINING

Training takes place on a Thursday evening at the Club situated at Allen Park, Swanbourne. 7's-12's train from 4.45-5.30pm and 13's-17's train from 5.15-6.30pm.

#### SATURDAY MATCHES

There are three venues for Junior Rugby in WA :- Britannia Oval, Thomas Oval (Kwinana) and Joondalup Reserve. Unless otherwise advised, the majority of SOAKS matches are to be played on a Saturday morning at Britannia Oval in Leederville. Match times differ slightly each week and, at the commencement of the season, can be located on the WAJRU web site as above.

#### KIT REQUIREMENTS FOR MATCHES

Associates play in green and gold.

The Associates playing kit consists of:

- Bottle Green shorts
- Green & Gold Socks

- **Footy boots**

Metal studs are allowed but please be aware that the refs will run their hands over them on inspection prior to each match, checking for spurs. Use of boots with metal studs on concrete surfaces may cause spurs on the studs.

- All players are required to wear the appropriate footwear and a mouthguard for both training and matches.

All clothing can be purchased from the Club rooms every Thursday once training commences. Cheques, made payable to Associates Rugby Club, are accepted along with eftpos and credit card payments.

Match jerseys will be allocated to each team at the start of the season.

The Club has a box of second hand boots kept at the Club House and they can be purchased for a small donation which goes to the Club.

**Mouth Guards:**

The Club has an authorised Dentist who is at the Club on training nights on two consecutive evenings at the start of the season to measure, fit and subsequently deliver mouthguards. Cheques/payments are made directly to the dentist. Otherwise you are welcome to make your own arrangements.

**Parents\players must ensure that mouthguards are brought to both training and matches.**

**EVENT INFORMATION**

The Club hold various social functions throughout the year. A popular event is the "True Colours" evening, with everyone along in their favourite team's rugby shirt – the mix can be quite amazing.

**There is also a Junior Presentation Night at the end of the Season when all players receive a team photo and a trophy, along with a hot beef roll and a drink.**

A discount of \$20 is given for a second and subsequent child/ren.

There will be an administration fee of \$50 deducted from any requested refund once registered. Refunds will not be available after round 2 of the competition.

## **JUNIOR PATHWAY**

**Walla Rugby** Up to 8 years - the simple non-tackling version of the game played on a modified field.

**Mini Rugby** 9 - 10 years - introduces young players to the contact element of the game.

**Midi Rugby** Up to 12 years - the stepping stone to the full game.

**U19 Laws** 13 years of age and upwards – the full game of rugby

## **PARENT ROSTERS**

### Match Days

On at least two Saturday mornings during the season our Club must take their turn on the parent roster at Britannia Oval, Leederville. This duty involves the whole Club being responsible for the 'set up' and 'take down' of the ground facilities. This is given to teams playing first and last and may require an earlier or later arrival/departure.

### Training Nights at Allen Park

Sausage Sizzle rosters will be organised with each team being responsible for two or three training nights over the season.

At the discretion of each manager, individual teams may also have rosters for half time oranges and washing of the team shirts. Your manager will require your assistance in these instances.

## **REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS**

A parent or guardian over the age of 18 years is required to:

- Sign & complete an Australian Rugby Union form [ARU]
- Sign & complete a WAJRU Image Disclaimer form
- New registrations must provide **Proof of Age** i.e. a **copy** of the child's birth certificate or passport
- Have the child's digital photo taken at the Club for their identification card – this photo will be valid for a three year period.
- Have paid their Registration fees in full
- Sign and complete an Associates Rugby Club Medical Form

***All forms must be completed at the Club House***

All registration requirements must be met **before** the registration can be forwarded to WAJRU and registered with ARU. Once the season commences all registrations done at Thursday night training will take 10 days to complete. Hence any player registering on a Thursday night **will not be eligible to play on the following Saturday.**
